Judith S. Palfrey, M.D., is Director of the Children's International Pediatric Center in the Department of Medicine at the Children's Hospital, Boston. She is the T. Berry Brazelton Professor of Pediatrics at Harvard Medical School, and Professor of Society and Human Development at Harvard School of Public Health. She received her A.B. degree from Radcliffe College in 1967 and an M.D. degree from Columbia University College of Physicians and Surgeons in 1971. Dr. Palfrey came to Children's in 1974 as a fellow in Community Child Health following her internship and residency in pediatrics at Albert Einstein College of Medicine in New York City. Dr. Palfrey is the author of Community Child Health: An Action Plan for Today, released by Praeger Press in November, 1994 and of Child Health in America: Making a Difference through Advocacy, Johns Hopkins Press, 2006. These books enhance understanding of community health and advocacy with practical guidelines on ways to build better futures for children and families.
